Charleston County Severe Weather Update #6

<u>Charleston County Government</u> has launched a limited activation of its Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in response to the severe weather event.

The County has moved to Operational Condition (OPCON) 3, which means a disaster or emergency situation is likely or imminent and can mean a full or partial activation of the Charleston County Emergency Operations Center and activation of the Charleston County Emergency Operations Plan. County officials ask the public to remain off the roads, if possible. Please note these County closings today:

- All Charleston County Public Library branches will remain closed today and all programs and any public bookings of meeting rooms are cancelled at the libraries as well.
- DAODAS Charleston Center outpatient services will be closed, but we will still be providing services in our Opioid Treatment Program and Inpatient services.
- Charleston County Bond Court will hold one session at 10:00 a.m. today and Sunday.
