Charleston County, SCDOT to Host Highway 78 Corridor Improvements Project Public Meeting

Charleston County Public Works officials, in partnership with the South Carolina Department of Transportation, will host a public meeting to provide updates on the Highway 78 Corridor Improvements Project on Wednesday, May 8, 2024, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Cypress Hall in Wannamaker Park, located at 888 University Boulevard in North Charleston.

The project includes a series of proposed improvements to Highway 78 from Rivers Avenue (US 52) to Berlin G. Myers Parkway (SC 165) designed to improve capacity, provide safe opportunities for bicyclists and pedestrians, and reduce congestion at key intersections.

During the drop-in style meeting, staff will present the results of recent traffic studies, introduce preliminary alternatives, and gather feedback from citizens.
